Also 12 new wood chairs with upholstered seats & 3 chairs, for each tutor room.

The meeting lasted an hour & a half with much discussion & many shared opinions. Choosing the best size for all tables was the most time-consuming task, requiring great foresight. There were several floor tapings in all sizes & different directions. In the end, everyone seemed satisfied to move forward.
